S.C a D.U Unit of Epidemiology, Regional Health Service ASL TO3 - Collegno (TO) (SEPI)

SEPI is a university-managed structure of the ASL TO3, active since 1994, which carries out activities of epidemiological study and research and promotion of health for the benefit of the Region, health authorities and local authorities of Piedmont. To this purpose, it develops, maintains and makes accessible the main sources of health data available in the region. It is also organized for specialist epidemiological observatories covering the main dimensions of Piedmontese health and healthcare, from assistance paths to prevention, from work-related risks to addictions, from mental health to accidents. Alongside factual data, the structure also promotes the processing and communication of non-factual data, through DORS, the only health documentation and promotion center available at regional level in Italy. Finally, the structure supports and manages academic training activities, such as degree courses in Prevention Techniques in the Environment and in the Workplace.

The Service is part of the Regional Epidemiology Network whose structures, as a whole, perform the functions of a regional epidemiological observatory.
